

Terms of Use/Service

Animoto - 13 years of age

Dropbox - Our Services are not directed to persons under 13. We do not knowingly collect personally identifiable information from children under 13. If a parent or guardian becomes aware that his or her child has provided us with Personal Information without their consent, he or she should contact us at privacy@dropbox.com. If we become aware that a child under 13 has provided us with Personal Information, we will take steps to delete such information from our files.

Edmodo - Parental Consent if under 18 years of age

Educreations - Children under 13 years old are not allowed to create an account without a parent or guardian's permission. We recommend that minors over the age of 13 ask their parents for permission before sending any information about themselves to anyone over the Internet.

Google Apps for Education - When offering online services to children under 13, schools must be cognizant of Child Online Privacy Protection Act (COPPA). COPPA is a regulation that requires parental consent for the online collection of information about users under 13. Per the Google Apps Education Edition Agreement, any school administering Google Apps Education Edition acknowledges and agrees that it is solely responsible for compliance with COPPA, including, but not limited to, obtaining parental consent concerning collection of students' personal information used in connection with the provisioning and use of the Services by the Customer and End Users.

Live Binders - 13 years of age

Prezi - 18 years of age or parental consent - require school email address

Fotobabble - Children under the age of 13 years are prohibited from using the Fotobabble service. You may not provide your username or password to any child under the age of 13 years.

Schoology - If you are a student and register to use the site you will be asked to provide an access code provided to you by your school administrator or teacher.

Voki - This site is a general audience site which is neither designed nor intended to collect personal information from children who are under the age of 13. In order to ensure compliance with the provisions of the Children's Online Privacy Protection Act (COPPA) children under the age of 13 should not provide any personal information to this site. We ask that parents supervise their children while online.

Classroom, a paid service, enables the account administrator (usually a teacher) to create student login, without providing student email addresses, or any personal contact information for students. Since there is no collection of personally identifiable or personal contact information, there is no need for age restriction on the use of Voki Classroom by students.
